Can I fill out a pledge card online?

Yes. Just go to www.allsaintsbirmingham.org and follow the "Stewardship".

How can I pay my pledge? There are several ways you can pay your pledge to All Saints' in addition to writing checks or cash. We offer E-Giving, Direct Deposit, and online bill pay options for the convenience of all parishioners.

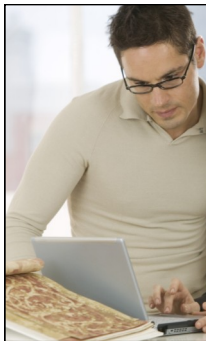
E-Giving is short for 'electronic giving' and allows you to give the ease of automatic transfers to All Saints' using your bank accounts, debit cards or credit cards. The set-up process is simple and the giving alternatives are secure.

The Direct Deposit option allows you to choose a specific amount to be withdrawn from your paycheck each month and deposited directly into the All Saints' account. Many people divide their pledge into monthly payments and have it automatically withdrawn from their paycheck, eliminating the need to write a check.

If you already use online bill pay to pay your power bill, mortgage payment, or other recurring payments, you can choose to pay your pledge to All Saints' the same way - through your checkbook or bank account. You can set this up through your bank website or by contacting your bank directly.

How do I get started? The sign up process is simple:
